Blessed are they who have not walked in the
counsel of the wicked, nor lingered in the way of
sinners, nor sat in the assembly of the scornful.

**Their delight is in the law of the Lord and they
meditate on his law day and night.**

Like a tree planted by streams of water
bearing fruit in due season, with leaves that do
not wither, whatever they do, it shall prosper.

**As for the wicked, it is not so with them;
they are like chaff which the wind blows away.**

Therefore the wicked shall not be able to stand in
the judgement, nor the sinner in the congregation
of the righteous.

**For the Lord knows the way of the righteous, but
the way of the wicked shall perish.**

[Pause] *Christ our wisdom, give us delight in your
law, that we may bear fruits of patience and
peace in the kingdom of the righteous; for your
mercy's sake.*

**Glory to God, Source of all being, eternal Word
and Holy Spirit; as it was in the beginning is
now and shall be for ever. Amen.**
